Any registered candidate who qualifies for interview as per Ph.D Ordinance VI of University of Delhi and points given below may report for interview

- Candidates who have qualified UGC- NET (including JRF)/ UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/ DBT-JRF. ICMR-JRF, DST-INSPIRE or equivalent national level examination/fellowship (as identified by DRC)/GATE/teacher fellowship holder may directly appear for interview.
- Teachers, who are in service in the University of Delhi, may directly appear for interview.
- Candidates holding Junior Research fellowships or equivalent research positions in projects, satisfying the minimum eligibility conditions (subject to selection by duly constituted committee as per the University norms for research projects) may also appear directly for interview.
- Scientists/professionals working at R&D institutes of the Government of India/State Government and with whom the University has signed a Memorandum of Understanding may directly appear for interview subject to fulfilling minimum eligibility criteria.
- Candidates who have been awarded or are pursuing M.Phil. Programme may directly appear for interview. Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. coursework with at least 55% marks in aggregate (or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and have successfully completed the M.Phil. degree with at least 55% marks shall be eligible for appearing directly for interview.
- No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
- Candidates must carry a copy of the Application Form/Admit Card and valid photo ID for the interview. Please note that Candidate has to bring one page SOP on the area of his/her research interest.
- Candidates should bring copy of Fellowship Award Letter, National entrance test certificate, Category Certificate, Non creamy layer certificate for OBC candidates, Mark-sheets and Certificates from class 10 onwards to present. Dissertation thesis, Publications, any other Testimonials for Academic Qualification are also encouraged.
- At the time of interview, the candidates are required to discuss their research interest/area through Power Point Presentation before the duly constituted Committee. The presentation (maximum 05 slides) should bullet the following:
  - Topic of research;
  - Unanswered questions;
  - Objectives;
  - Key methods to be used;
  - Expected outcome


