Vision of the Program

- > Clearly outline the objectives and expectations of the mentorship relationship by ensuring that both mentor and mentee have a shared understanding of their roles and responsibilities.
- > Providing guidance on academic matters, course selection, and study strategies and offer insights into the mentee's chosen field, sharing experiences and advice on career development.
- > Facilitating introductions to relevant professionals and industries contacts and helping mentees in developing networking skills
- Assessing the mentee's strengths and weaknesses to tailor guidance and support through providing constructive feedback to help the mentee improve their skills and performance.
- > Helping the mentee identify and navigate challenges, providing guidance and alternative perspectives.
- > Fostering independent thinking and problem-solving skills in the mentee.
- > Bridging Communication between students and the administration.
- > Maintain confidentiality regarding the mentee's personal and academic information.

Details of the Program

- > The mentees preferably be attached to the same mentor for the entire duration of the first year of the programme.
- Mentors should meet the mentees once every month, enquire about the difficulties they might be facing and assess their academic progress.
- > The mentor will function as a bridge between students and the administration
- Mentors will also actively motivate mentees to take part in curricular and extracurricular activities and help shape their career goals.
- > The mentor shall meet the mentees regularly and record the outcome of the meeting in the attendance register.
